1. Terminology and relationship

1.1. OPEN ACCESS (OA)

- **the access to the online information for free** and by anyone interested to use it;
- **international initiatives, statements and declarations** that support OA: Budapest Initiative (2002), Bethesda Statement (2003), Berlin Declaration (2003), IFLA Statement (2004), Ghent Declaration (2011);
- **Creative Commons licenses (CC)** - helps creators retain copyright while allowing others to copy, distribute, and make some uses of their work
- OA literature is the result of **public-funded research**;
- **the ways of publishing** OA information:
 - **Golden OA** publishing (*Directory of Open Access Journals*);
 - **Green OA** self-archiving (*Directory of Open Access Repositories*).

1.2. OPEN SOURCE SOFTWARE (OSS)

- a software, available in source code form, provided under a **free software license**;
- users can download, evaluate, change or improve and also distribute the software
- **General Public Licenses** (GNU or GPLv3) - guarantee the freedom of sharing and changing all versions of a software;
- tools for learning and developing competencies.

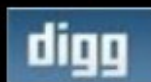

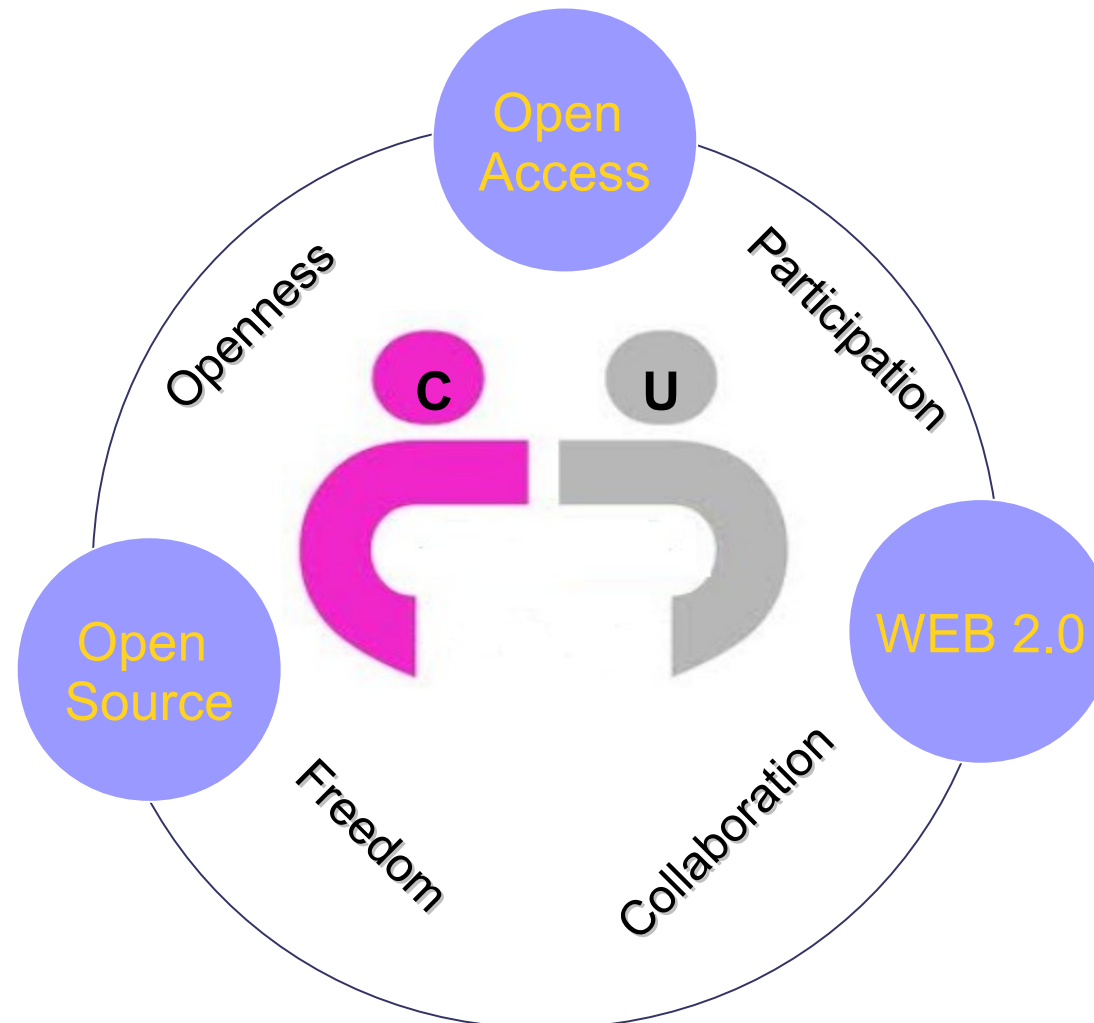

- Connotea & Zotero, for references management.

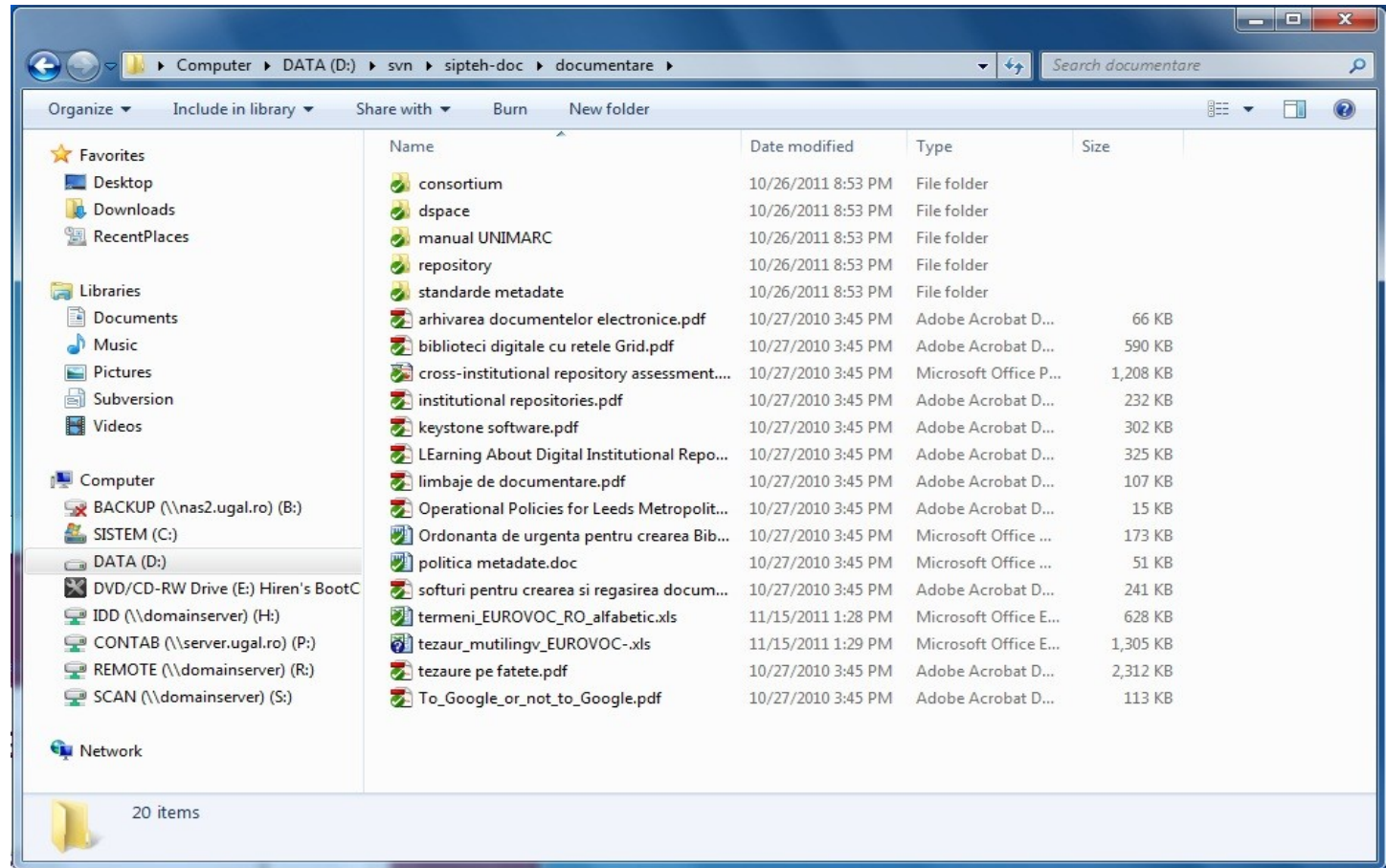

2.2. OPEN SOURCE SOFTWARE

Checkout - the act of creating a local working copy from the repository.

Commit - the action of writing or merging the changes made in the working copy back to the repository.

Update (or sync) - merges changes made in the repository.

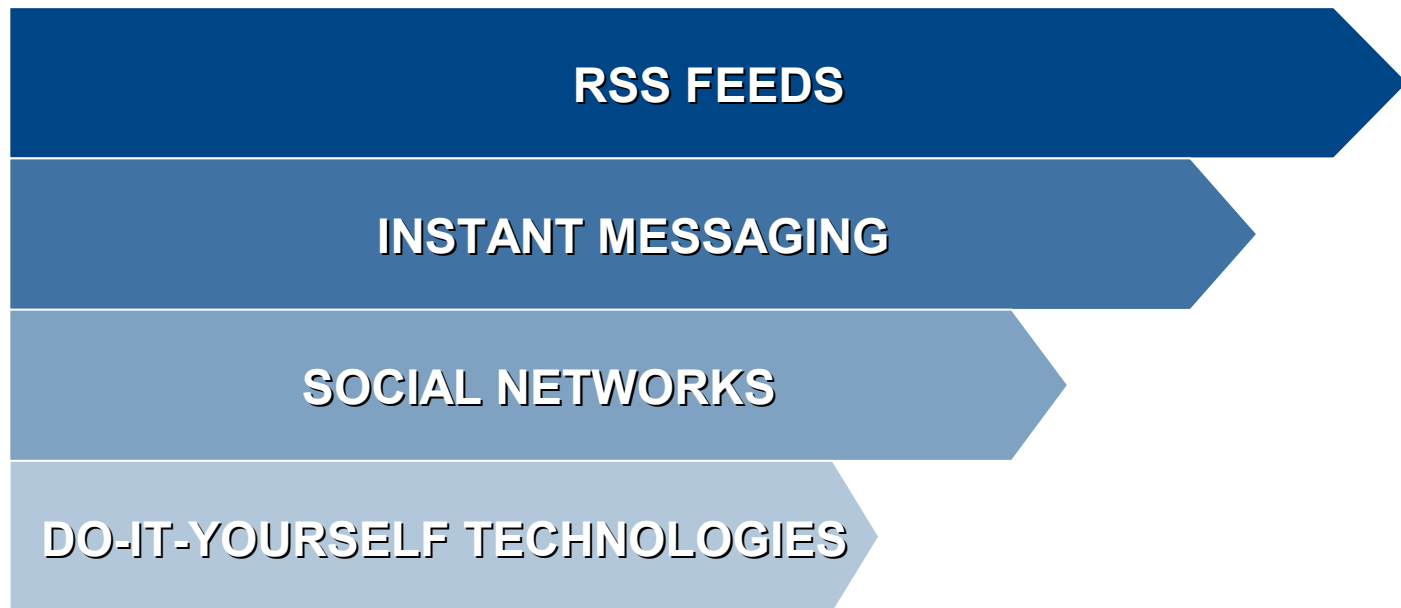




